At Chrysalis House, we provide a safe, non-judgmental environment offering shelter and outreach services for women and children affected by violence and abuse. Through support, advocacy, resources, and public education, we empower women to make their own choices and live free from violence.

Our mission is to create a supportive space where women and children can find hope and healing. Serving the West Hants, Kings, and Annapolis counties, we offer crisis and transitional services that prioritize empowerment, dignity, and respect.

About the Role

As a Part Time Night Worker, you will play a vital role in our shelter and outreach programs. The schedule consists of two 12 hour working shifts every Saturday and Sunday night from 8pm to 8am. Responsibilities include:

- Providing services through our **24-hour crisis line**.
- Offering direct support to women and children in our care.
- Collaborating with the team to support various programs as needed.
- You are eligible to accept relief/casual shifts on top of the part time hours.

The ideal candidate is an **energetic, compassionate, and open-minded woman** who thrives in a high-stress environment and is capable of working independently or as part of a team.

Qualifications:

- Strong understanding of **violence against women** and its impact.
- Relevant education and/or professional experience.

- Experience in providing support and advocacy in community-based settings (preferred).
- Ability to remain calm and efficient in challenging situations.
